Storyline Notes (updated 09/04/21)

Boreoans

Mysterious secluded race in Northern Houress. Surrounded by deadly energy barrier. Party has discovered that they are a race of clones with no genitalia. There are four classes of Boreoans:

- 1. Laborers: right side of body is white; left is black. They perform menial jobs.
- 2. Intellects: left side of body is black; right is white. They perform intellectual jobs.
- 3. Enforcers: Entire body is black. They enforce rules/laws.
- 4. Alphas: Entire body is white. They are the leaders.

They are very keen on not having the values of outsiders corrupting their utopian society. Evidently, they can use selective memory modification to remove any memories they choose, such as memories of the outside world/people.

Lucieth

Hails from Garland. He is a wererat who hates that he has lycanthropy, something shared by his and other clans that live in Garland. Having been born of lycanthropy, his curse is not curable (those who are bitten can be cured magically).

Lucieth and his allies are in conflict with vampire clans that live in Garland. Although they've been enjoying a shaky peace for many years, he and other fear that the peace may end soon. Lucieth is trying to find a way to break free of his curse and end the conflict with the nosferatu.

He formed a plan when he heard that the mysterious Boreoans were impervious to disease. He set out to find one of them and came across Roger. Lucieth and the party found that Roger's people are clones and are grown and then somehow programmed with the intelligence they need to live their lives.

Lucieth, with the help of his ally Khaligren the beholder, figured that if they could somehow transfer the consciousness of an infected lycanthrope into a newly-grown clone body, they could escape their curse. To that end, Luceith and the Misifits found Tarkoff, a man from another world (Corothka), who had transferred his own consciousness into a mechanical body. Tarkoff offered to do what Lucieth asked in exchange for a body for himself and something else (see Tarkoff).

Roger (QPORO1255)

Roger and a companion had escaped Boreoa because they wanted to see the outside world. His companion was killed before Roger met Lucieth and began traveling with him. Roger

is a clone whose skin on the right side is white and the left side black. He has blue eyes and no hair. He has no genitalia and is ignorant of love and copulation.

He can do surface scans of people's minds, and he also can project a psychic blast against other creatures at short distances.

About the time the party found him and Lucieth, Roger had decided to go home. His decision came after some Boreoan Enforcers came after him to bring him back. One of the enforcers, who was named Phillip, has had a change of heart about the outside world and Roger's guilt and has joined the party.

Tarkoff

Lives in Onthgeloom in Dockrawlin. He is from Corothka, another world like Irith. He transferred his consciousness to a mechanical body because his flesh and bone body was wasting away from an incurable disease. He fled through a portal in a military installation that he broken into to steal things for money to pay for a better body.

In his quest to return home, Tarkoff has found a place called the "Labyrinth of Gates", where there are portals leading to other worlds. Before they can be used, a 50-sided polyhedron called a "pentacontagon" that is a key to open the portals, and a lexicon with the code combinations for each world.

The Misfits have agreed to get the two items in exchange for helping Lucieth with transferring consciousnesses from his clan into unprogrammed clone bodies.

Tarkoff also indicated that gods are actually eldritch titans who came to Irith from another world. Some of the titans terraformed Irith with magic before their brothers betrayed them and then became the current Irith gods.

All Creator

There is a myth that there is a being that created everything called the "All Creator". This being is supposed to be a god above gods. The Misfits have come across information and a few believes in this creator. They even looked through a magical telescope into a nebula in the heavens where the All Creator supposedly lives in a Silver Kingdom.

Cain

An immortal who killed his brother long before the current gods came to Irith. For his sin, his father, the All Creator, cursed him to roam the world forever. He can be killed but will come back, fully resurrected. The last the party saw of him, he and a few followers from the Wildlands, decided to journey to the ice reaches of the Top of the World. The party has an open invitation to come visit.

Cain also informed the party that the gods currently ruling the heavens and below had come to the world a very long time ago before leaving and then returning after the cleansing of the light.

Qa'Suul the Unholy Tormentor

Qa'Suul is a devil prince residing on the plane of Korthaganos. An imp that temporarily taken over Squirk and was later killed and sent back to the lower realms informed his masters of what he learned from Squirk and the world of Irith.

Qa'Suul took an interest in the gods that were stirring up trouble with magic and wizards and then began sending emissaries to inhabit mortal bodies. The party learned from Qa'Suul's emissaries that if the rogue gods caused too much chaos, the balance of life and death on Irith and beyond would be shattered for all.

The emissaries would join the party for a short time. He/she would learn from the party what they could. In exchange, they would relay to the party what Qa'Suul had learned about the godly conflict. Each body would only survive a short time before dying, sending the devilish emissary back to its home plane.

Assault on Wizards

For the past few years, more people than ever are looking at wizards with angry, mistrusting eyes. Aside from attacks from those in the political arena and even organizations such as thieves guilds and others, someone has concocted a disease that sickens and kills wizards who continue to use magic. The disease is called the "Corux."

The party has worked to help find a cure for the Corux, which has just been perfected. The party has also found that most of the wizard assault is happening in the southern part of the continent.

Another element to the mix is that priests/followers of several particular gods have proven to be responsible for harassing the wizards. The gods are: Avizor, Ianlia, Qurophys, Thirion, Su Reh, Breahal, Vor, and Ya Nu.

Recently, it seems that followers of the other gods are attacking the followers of the 9.

Labyrinth of Gates

A place allegedly created by the gods and is filled with chambers housing portals leading to other worlds. The caretaker of the labyrinth is Voracianus, the demi-god son of Ardru. Each gate is ringed by 50 rune symbols. The Misfits are aiming to find a 50-sided polyhedron called a pentacontagon, which is a key to activating the runes. They are also looking to find a lexicon created by the eldritch titans that tells the combination for each gate.
